1. You need to be 18 or over;
2. You must be a local government elector for the Alveley and Romsley Parish, or have worked (sole or principal occupation) in the Parish for at least twelve months, or have resided within the Parish or within 4.8 km of it for at least twelve months;
3. You will need in due course to submit a nomination paper which must be endorsed by a Proposer and a Seconder;
4. The proposer and seconder must be local government electors of the Alveley and Romsley parish;
5. If there are eleven or less valid nominations, all those nominated will become Parish Councillors;
6. If there are more than eleven valid nominations, an election will be held on 6th May 2021 and the eleven candidates with the most votes will become Parish Councillors on 10th May 2021.
